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COVID 19 UPDATE - 10 November 2021

The outbreak in Chinook Village has been declared over by Public Health officials! Our outbreak started on Aug 4th and ended Nov 9th. We had 7 staff tested positive and 8 residents from Supportive and Assisted Living, both vaccinated and unvaccinated, test positive. Please see below for current health and safety protocols as per Public Health orders and guidelines.

Independent Living - (Chief Medical Officer of Health Orders #44 and #45.)

Indoor social gatherings

- Vaccinated: Indoor private social gatherings are limited to 2 households (yours plus one other) up to a maximum of 10 vaccine-eligible, vaccinated people and no restrictions on children under 12.
- Unvaccinated: Indoor social gatherings are not permitted for vaccine-eligible people who are unvaccinated.
- This restriction does not apply to mutual support groups, or to workers who need to access your home to provide caregiving support or home repairs and maintenance.

Outdoor social gatherings

- Outdoor private social gatherings limited to a maximum of 20 people, with 2 metre physical distancing between households always.

Masking

- A person must always wear a face mask while attending indoor public place. Public place does not include a rental accommodation used solely for the purposes of a private residence.
- Mandatory masking in Supportive and Assisted Living areas.

Physical Distancing

- For all indoor and outdoor activities and settings, a person must maintain a physical distance of 2 meters from any person who is not part of the person's cohort.

Lounges

- No adult may attend, nor may an operator offer, any indoor location of a business or entity for the purposes of participating in a group physical activity, group performance activity, group recreation activity or a competition or similar activity. (Order #44)
- If a resident wishes to book a lounge, masking, and proof of vaccination for all participants will be required as per Order #45.

Corner Store



- Open. Residents should access the Corner Store through the parkade. Masking required.

Library

- Open. Residents should access the library through the parkade. Masking mandatory.

Guest Suites

- Resident families will be able to book one guest suite and proof of vaccination will be required. Resident and families are reminded of the indoor social gathering restrictions.

Terrace Room

- Christmas banquets will be hosted the week of December 13 – 17. Proof of vaccination and mandatory masking will be required for all residents and guests.
- Dining in the main dining room will also require screening at Reception, mandatory masking and proof of vaccination.

Supportive and Assisted Living - (Chief Medical Officer of Health Orders #37 and #39)

Visitors

- All visitors, including Independent residents, must mask continuously while on site, including in resident rooms.
- All visitors, including Independent residents, must screen at Reception prior to entry.

Activities

- Activities will resume. Please check activity calendar.
