Re: COVID Restrictions Update

The Chief Medical Officer of Health has issued new orders removing many of the previous COVID restrictions while keeping others in place. Any remaining restrictions will be reviewed again in the fall.

As a resident, you are not required to mask nor physical distance. Further, you can come and go as you like, no need to check in at reception any longer! There is no resident symptom monitoring nor is there high touch cleaning in resident rooms. All the lounges are open once again and yes, puzzles and card playing can resume.

Effective immediately, there are no restrictions on who may come and visit, nor is prebooking visits required. You may have any number of visitors and may visit them in your suite, in a common area or outside. Visitors, however, must screen at reception (no temperature necessary) and mask with a medical/surgical mask when they are in any common area. It is up to you as to whether or not they mask in your suite, however, all children under the age of 12 and non-vaccinated visitors are strongly encouraged to mask while in suite as well.

NOTE: While these restrictions do not apply to the Independent living areas, Independent Living residents are considered a 'visitor' when in the Supportive and/or Assisted Living areas and must screen and mask when in the Supportive and Assisted Living areas.
